

CORONAVIRUS NOTICE: UNION STATION WAITING TIMES

Due to COVID-19 (Coronavirus) and in compliance with Executive Orders issued by the Governor, as well as directives issued by the Center for Disease Control and the Department of Public Health, we are limiting the amount of time that any person may spend inside the Transportation Center of Union Station in order to sustain social distancing and prevent impermissible gatherings.

If you are not travelling or unless you are purchasing a rail or bus ticket than you may not linger or wait inside the building for any unacceptable amount of time. (SEE BELOW)

- Individuals purchasing tickets have up to (15) minutes to do so.
- If an individual is only here to purchase food from Subway or Dunkin Donuts if they are open, they have a total of 20-minutes to buy the food and either eat it in the Transportation Center or leave with the food.
- If you are waiting for a bus or train than you must not wait inside the Station for more than (30) minutes prior to your mode of travel. You certainly may wait outside for up to two hours if you are early for your bus or train.
- If you miss the bus or train you are required to leave if there is not another one scheduled within two hours. However; you must wait outside the Transportation Center and not inside the facility.
- No one will be let into Union Station during the posted hours that it is closed!
- IF YOU ARE SICK OR SHOW ANY SYMPTOMS DETERMINED TO BE OF CONCERN TO OUR SECURITY OFFICERS YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO WAIT INSIDE THE BUILDING FOR THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OF ALL.
