ADDENDUM #2

The Request for Proposal (RFP) is modified/clarified as set forth in this Addendum. The original RFP Documents remain in full force and effect, except as modified/clarified by this Addendum, which is hereby made part of the RFP. Respondent shall take this Addendum into consideration when preparing and submitting its proposal.

Proposals are due on or before 2:30 PM local time, Tuesday, October 22, 2024 at the District offices located at One Union Place, Hartford, CT.

The following previously submitted inquiry (in reference to RFP #01-025) has been further clarified:

- 1. Question: Are the cameras run over CAT 5 or Coax? Any offsite monitoring? Is there a lift available on site or would we need to rent?**

Answer: Both. Some cameras run over Coax and some on CAT5. Key District staff members have the ability to access security footage remotely via cell phone and control certain software features. The District owns a lift on premises. The Proposer would need to get clearance from the District's Executive Director and/or his designee prior to use. The Proposer would need to be certified in the operation and use of the lift before being cleared to use. It should be noted that the current video surveillance PM contractor has been able to access all camera equipment with a standard 10-12-foot ladder.
